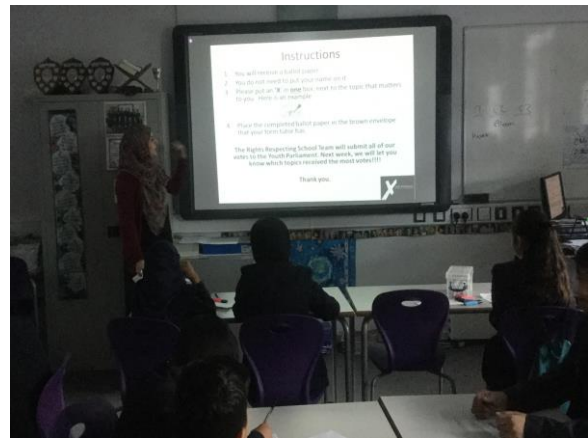


Youth Parliament Vote
